

Greater Rochester Heritage Days Rules

*Welcome! Greater Rochester Heritage Days is a community-wide celebration of our shared history and community. The success of the festival depends of the cooperation of all groups involved. We hope you enjoy participating in this event. - Dogs are not permitted in the Park during special events such as this per City of Rochester Ordinance, unless they are official “service” dogs.
- Alcohol is prohibited in the Park per City of Rochester ordinance.
- No overnight camping is allowed in the Park.
- All motorized vehicles are to be operated in a safe manner and must be removed from the park by **10:00 a.m. Sat. & Sun.** They may not re-enter the Park until after 6:00 p.m. Sat. and 5:00 p.m. Sun. **Please respect the park grounds at all times, and use extra caution when using your vehicle - take care not to drive off the path especially in treed areas.**
- **You may set up Friday between 4-7p.m. or Saturday morning 8-10a.m.**
- Cleanliness is to be maintained in and around your concession area at all times, including trash container maintenance. Excess trash should be placed in the dumpsters at the entrances to the park.
- All amplified music or speech shall be kept to a level which does not cause disruption of neighboring activities on the grounds or surrounding residential property.
- Please be friendly and courteous to other groups and volunteers, this is a team effort and we can’t succeed without your cooperation and patience.
- The Festival will go on rain or shine. We ask that all groups maintain their presence in the park during the entire festival.
